With reference to Mr. Laing's letter of the 23rd instant forwarding for consideration two plans of a new turbine proposed to be constructed by Messrs. Ateliers et Chantiers de Penhoet, St Nazaire, for the S.S. "MARYLAND", I have to inform you that with steam turbines of 2650 shaft horse power at 3600 revolutions per minute, the proposed arrangement of action and reaction type turbine will be approved, provided the turbine be constructed as shewn on the plan and to your satisfaction.

Further, the proposed tensile strength and elongation limits of the material of the shafts and discs will also be approved.

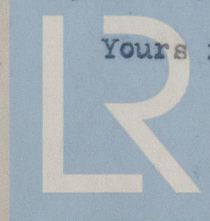
It is concluded that provision will be made for draining the core of the rotor, but I shall be glad if you will confirm this.
