Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 14th instant respecting the Steamer "BOSILJKA" and in reply would explain that in accordance with the Committee's wartime practice Special Surveys of vessels trading in the Allied interests have been suspended during the present emergency.

These Surveys have been replaced by General Examinations as explained in the enclosed circular letter which was sent to Ship Owners in December 1940.

The Special Survey No.2 of the "BOSILJKA" would normally have become due in September 1941 and a General Examination for maintenance of class will not be required until September 1942.

The Annual Boiler Survey became due in February last and it is understood the vessel was under the inspection of the New Orleans Surveyors in March last but his report has not yet come to hand.
