With reference to your letter of the 29th  
Sept. regarding the "Bandai Maru" 3553, I beg to state  
that

1. The pillars & girders are fitted as approved,
2. The Face bars on the Web Frames & side Stringers  
of the Forecastle deck beams were approved locally.
3. Rider plates 12" x .56 were fitted to strong hold  
beams.
4. The thickness of 'F' strake should read .56
5. The thickness of shelter deck sheerstrake at Fore  
end should read .50
