Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have again had before them the case of your Dredger "LA LOIRE", referred to in recent correspondence between us, and with regard to the remarks in your letter of the 25th instant I have to say that as the vessel has not been brought under survey forthwith as required by the terms in my letter of the 19th instant, the Committee regret that they have no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have at the same time to add that the vessel will be eligible to be recommended to the Committee for the re-instatement of her character in the Register Book upon receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors to the effect that all requisite surveys and repairs have been carried out.
