With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the dredger "LA LOIRE", regarding which enquiries have been addressed from time to time to your goodsselves both at your City and West End Offices and also at your Office in Paris on the subject of the Special Survey No. 2 and Boiler Survey, which are much overdue, I have to acquaint you that the Committee, who have had the case under further consideration to-day, regret there will be no option but to expunge the class of the vessel forthwith from the Register Book unless arrangements are at once made for her to be now surveyed as required.

I should add that action in the case has been deferred by the Committee for a few days, awaiting the receipt of any proposal which you may desire to make in the matter.
