The Special Survey No. 2 became due 8.17.

A general examination was made, as far as practicable, by the Marseilles Surveyors in December last and the vessel found in a satisfactory condition, *but nothing was done regarding the Boiler survey which became due in Aug 15*

The Surveyors at that time stated that it was proposed to hold the Special Survey in about two months, and that this, in their opinion, was satisfactory.

The Owners' Agents stated on the 16th April that they expected the vessel to arrive at Marseilles within the next three months in order to load further gear, and trusted that it would then be possible for the survey to be carried out, and hoped the Committee would kindly grant this further extension of time.

The case received consideration on the 25th April, when the Owners were informed that the Committee had decided to again defer action for the present, but they trusted definite arrangements would be made for the Special Survey No. 2 to be held on the vessel's return to Marseilles within the next three months, in order that the vessel's classification might be duly maintained.

In reply to enquiry, the Marseilles Surveyor now states nothing has been done in the case, the vessel not having come under survey or
