Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo relative to the surveys overdue on the Dredger "LA LOIRE", and to acquaint you that the case has received the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting to-day.

The Committee desire me to point out that this vessel's boilers have not been examined by the Society's Surveyors since April 1914, and in the circumstances they must ask you to be good enough to take up the matter with the Charterers, with a view to the Boiler Survey being carried out without delay, and to the vessel being generally examined by the Society's Surveyors. Provided this be done and a satisfactory report be received, the Committee will not object to the completion of the Special Survey No. 2 being postponed until the completion of the Charter as desired.

I shall therefore be obliged if you will kindly let me know for the Committee's information what arrangements are made in the matter.
