Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the Dredger "LA LOIRE", which vessel it is understood is now your property, I beg to acquaint you that the Boiler and Screw Shaft Surveys became due at the end of August 1915 and May 1916 respectively, while the Special Survey No. 2 became due at the end of August 1917, and that the Committee have allowed the vessel's class to remain undisturbed only on the understanding that the Boiler and Screw Shaft Surveys are held, and the Special Survey No. 2 is carried out, or a General Examination made in accordance with the terms of the accompanying Circular Letter before the vessel is again employed.

I shall therefore be glad if you will let me know for the information of the Committee what steps you propose taking in the matter.
