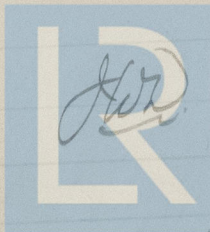
The Special Survey No.2 became due 8. 17.

A general examination was made, as far as practicable, by the Marseilles Surveyors in December last and the vessel found in a satisfactory condition. *The boiler survey became due 8.17.*

The Surveyors at that time stated that it was proposed to hold the Special Survey in about two months, and that this, in their opinion, was satisfactory.

The Owners' Agents now state that they expect the vessel to arrive at Marseilles within the next three months in order to load further gear, and trust that it will then be possible for the survey to be carried out; and hope the Committee will kindly grant this further extension of time.

In the circumstances, it is submitted action might be deferred, and the Marseilles Surveyor advised.
