Yard No. 429 - Plan of Pillars and Girders.

I return herewith one copy of the above plan submitted with your letter of the 7th instant, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that the scantlings and arrangements as shown and amended thereon will be approved, provided they be carried out to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

The electric welding should be carried out to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors and the Regulations for the Application of Electric Arc Welding to Ship Construction should be complied with.

I have also to inform you with regard to your letter, that if alternative arrangements of girders in way of the pillar heads be adopted, they should be equivalent to those shown and amended on the plan to the Surveyors satisfaction.

The remaining copy of the plan has been retained in this Office for record.
