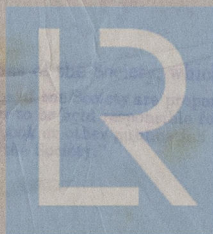

Master of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that **THE VESSEL**
IS BEEN BUILT UNDER SPECIAL SURVEY.

I have Recommended that she be *Classed 7 100 A.1.*
date of build 3-20, and a provisional
depth of 3'-3½" from the top of the statutory
deck line to the centre of the keel, the statutory
deck line being 1¾" above the steel upper edge at side.
fit for carrying oil fuel A.P. above 150°F in fore &
peak tanks, and in double bottom under cargo hold.
to carry *dry and perishable*
cargoes.
