The CALCUTTA Surveyor reports (4.43) the vessel placed in dry dock and bottom coated.

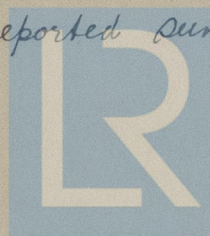
An "On Survey" has been completed by the examination of the oil fuel bunkers (p & s) and all deep tanks in way of Nos.2,4 & 6 hatchways.
