"BERAKIT" 6608 tons gross of Batavia, and which have since been sent to Calcutta to be put on board.

All the 15 liners were of sound high quality cast iron and were free from flaws or any surface defects or marks. They were finally examined when finished, machined and each one was tested at 500 lbs. per Square inch hydraulic pressure and found tight.
