This Dutch vessel was built in 1924 and classed with the Germanischer Lloyd or other Society.

The SYDNEY Surveyors report (12.42) the vessel examined afloat on account of damage through heavy weather and repairs effected to numerous deck fittings.

A GENERAL EXAMINATION has been carried out in accordance with Circular 1772.

The deck plating was found generally in good condition but somewhat worn abreast hatchways but efficient.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to have notations of 100A1 Classification Contemplated and 'Examined 12.42' valid for 12 months assigned as recommended.
