H. Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that to complete the survey for classification of the motor vessel "LEWES CASTLE" recently built by Messrs. Gebrueders Root, two small air receivers (approved by the Committee) which have been placed on board require to be hydraulically tested in the presence of the Society's Surveyors to twice the working pressure \approx of 175 lb. per square inch. The following items of spare gear also require to be supplied, namely:-

2 Top end bolts and nuts;
2 bottom end bolts and nuts;
2 main bearing bolts and nuts;
1 set of coupling bolts;
An approved fire extinguisher.

In reply to enquiry Messrs. James Pollock & Co., Ltd., state that it would be convenient to have the receivers tested in London, but should, however, the vessel not come to this port in the near future, they will arrange to have the work done at Antwerp. I shall therefore be glad if you will be guided accordingly, and give the case the necessary attention in the
