Dear Mr. Scott:

With reference to your letter of the 10th ultimo and to San Francisco report No.2778 on the steamer "ACCOMAC", I enclose herewith a letter dated the 12th instant received from the Surveyors from which it will be seen that the screw shaft of this vessel is not fitted with a continuous liner, the liner being in three pieces and burned at the joints as required by the Rules.
