Dear Sir,

S. I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Barry state that the steamer "CAPITAINE ILLAQUER" is at present in dry dock there with damage and that upon offering their services in the usual way they were informed by the Master that the vessel is now classed with the Bureau Veritas and that her classification with this Society has been dropped.

Nothing is known of the matter in this Office, and I shall accordingly be glad if you will at once make enquiries of the Owners on the subject, pointing out that for the retention of the vessel's class in Lloyd's Register the Society's Rules require all repairs to be effected under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, and you should cable the result.
