**PANAMANIAN TANKER SU**  
RIO SAN JOE, Wednesday  
The Panamanian motor tanker  
Ben Brush sank about 40 miles off

on Apr. 12. Two men bearing 25  
survivors landed at Ceará, in the  
State of Ceará. The men were later  
flown to the port of Natal. — Reuter.
