Dear Sir,

E. I send herewith a copy of an order which has been placed by The Rowhedge Ironworks Co. Ltd. with Messrs. Bryan, Donkin & Co. Ltd. for a 20 ton centrifugal self-priming bilge pump required for the Builders' Yard No.585.

I also enclose a copy of a letter which has to-day been addressed to The Rowhedge Ironworks Co. in regard to the matter, and shall be glad if you will witness the tests on board the vessel, paying special attention to the self-priming capability of the pump and its ability to handle bilge water containing waste, chips, sawdust, grain or other matter usually found in ships' bilges.

I have to add that if the Builders do not wish to carry out these detailed tests on board the vessel, it will be necessary for them to be carried out at the Makers' Works, for which a special fee will be chargeable, since the pump in question does not appear to have been submitted previously for general acceptance on vessels classed with the Society.
