

I duly received your letter of the 28th ultimo, submitting a plan of Cargo Pumping Arrangements proposed for the above vessel, and in reply have to inform you that this plan will be approved as shown and amended, provided the remaining requirements of Sections 21 and 22 of the Society's Rules for Vessels Carrying Petroleum in Bulk be complied with so far as they are applicable.

One copy of the plan is returned herewith, and it is observed that a plan showing ventilating arrangements for the cargo oil tanks will be submitted at a later date. Plans of pumping arrangements forward and in machinery space should also be forwarded for consideration.
