Dear Sirs,

E. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 16th instant with further reference to the material for the various tanks for your Yard No.585, and note your remarks.

In reply I have to inform you that plates to British Standard Specification No.15 will be approved for the construction of fuel service tanks in this instance provided the plates are not flanged and the work be carried out under the usual conditions of survey and testing. The plates should, however, be made from Open Hearth Steel and not from Bessemer Steel.

Further, no exception will be taken to the use of plates to B.S.S. No.15 in the case of the lubricating oil tanks and cooling water tank.
