I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th instant relating to various oil and water tanks for the above vessel, and note your remarks.

In reply I have to inform you that since it appears that the construction of the fuel service tank involves flanging of the plates, the tensile strength of the material should be between 26 and 30 tons per sq. inch, and it is suggested that the material be ordered to B.S.S. No.13 "Structural Steel for Shipbuilding. Cold Flanging Quality".
