
I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant enclosing copies of drawings Nos. 4317 & 3895 of windlass and capstan proposed to be supplied by Messrs. Hyland Ltd. for the Rowhedge Ironworks Co's No. 585, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that this Society has no regulations respecting the design or construction of capstans, and the only reference in the Rules to windlasses is set forth in Section 40, para.7. The responsibility, therefore, for the design of these items is a matter for the Makers and Builders, except that the Society's Surveyors will be required to satisfy themselves that the windlass is of suitable size for the cable.

You should, however, attend the Makers' Works and test any castings in accordance with the Society's requirements and issue a certificate.

The plans are returned herewith.
