We are obliged by yours of the 30th ult re the time for the drawing of the tail end shaft of the Rennyhill. This ship is still known as the Dyker Lassie her name not having been changed owing to the vessel having been condemned by the underwriters. The Peterhead Insurance Coy. We may say that the present owners bought the ship on the strength of her having been built to your specification and although we are advised that there is no claim for error of description no guarantee being given by your surveyors we may say that this experience which will most probably be well aired in the courts before a settlement is reached will most certainly do your society as a classification society a good deal of harm. We are at present trying to see if the Admiralty will not meet the poor fishermen owners who have been let down before deciding upon any line of action.
