Sir

I am duly in receipt of your letter of the 14<sup>th</sup> inst about the first entry report No 338 on the steamer "Lizzie". With regard to your request concerning the depts of this vessel, I have to state, that the dept from top of floors to top of main deck beam was taken at the ~~second~~<sup>first</sup> beam forward of 2<sup>nd</sup> bulk head and found to be 17'-4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" and the measurement for the moulded dept was taken from top of tank at the margin plate to top of this beam, and after the necessary subtractions was made the result was 19'-9<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" for the "Lizzie".

I do not now remember if these measurements was taken at the same beam for the "Minnie", so a slight difference may arise from this.

The two steamers are built after the same plans and to the same measurements and as the difference in the one measur is only <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> inch, I think the recording of the depts for the two steamers may be the same.
