Mr. Bohre stated that he is nearly always away from home  
which is to explain the delay; this appears true enough as I  
have never been able to see him or to get him at the  
telephone.

It does not appear to be settled yet in what tier the vessel  
will be employed, but as a preliminary measure the bills  
will be submitted to Dutch Government Inspection next  
week and it has been agreed that the Society's inspection  
will be held at the same time.
