This vessel was originally owned by the London County Council and has recently been sold to Mr. K. Bohre of Rotterdam. In reply to an inquiry the Rotterdam Surveyors stated at the beginning of May that they had received no definite information as regards the vessel's class or employment but that in all probability she would be employed in the service Rotterdam-Middelharnis, which would in the Surveyors' opinion not interfere with her classification, as vessels trading in the estuaries are not considered to be seagoing vessels in the new Dutch Law of Shipping. The Surveyors were informed that the present class would be applicable for such navigation.
