Survey due *Screw Shaft Survey due May, 1912*

On the 24th January last the Committee agreed to a proposal of the Owner to have the shaft examined about the end of April.

The Aberdeen Surveyors now forward telegrams which have passed between them and the Owner from which it would appear that the Owner stated the vessel was on the slipway at Lossiemouth on the 22nd instant for screw shaft survey. In reply the Surveyors informed the Owner that it was impossible to attend until the 24th instant. The Owner stated that the vessel would be off the slipway at forenoon of the 24th instant, without fail. The Surveyors again wired the Owner stating that if desired



they <sup>would</sup> ~~will~~ survey the screw shaft at twelve noon on the 24th instant, but in reply the Owner stated that the vessel would be floated at noon on the 24th and the survey would not be needed.

The Surveyors state that owing to the number of vessels being placed on the various slipways, and pontoons at Aberdeen, it was impossible without due notice to make a journey to Lossiemouth which occupies an entire day, and upon the receipt of the Owner's latest telegram no further action was taken in the matter.
