This "Kil" class vessel was built in 1918 under the survey of the British Corporation, being similar to other vessels constructed under this Society's supervision to plans mutually approved by Lloyd's Register and the British Corporation and classed A1 "For Government Service".

The vessel came under the Society's survey in July, 1920, when considerable alterations were made to render her suitable for carrying cargo, and she was then classed 100A1 with this Society.

The question has now been raised as to when the Special Survey No.1 will become due.

It is submitted the Hull Surveyors be asked to state whether the survey held by them in July 1920 could be considered as complying with the requirements of a Special Survey No.3 in order that the Special Survey No.1 might be dated from the completion of that survey.
