I have to inform you that it appears from a First Entry Report received from the Society's Surveyors at Hull that the S. S. "MAXTON" has proceeded to your port, and to complete the Survey the following work remains to be done, namely:-

Decks to be retested, new pins to be supplied to several of the engine room skylight hinges, 3rd bower anchor to be replaced by one of correct weight and test, equipment of wires and ropes to be supplied, and freeboard to verify.

I shall be glad if you will be good enough to give this matter the necessary attention and forward a report on form 8 on completion of the Survey, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
