Further to our letter of 8th March in reply to yours of 1st March regarding the two wood auxiliary motor vessels "**PIETRO BRIZZOLARI**" ex "CAP HORN" and "**MARIA BRIZZOLARI**" ex "CAP VERT", I have to inform you that the Owner called at this Office a few days ago to discuss the matter, and also that Mr. Ives and I had a discussion at the Offices of the Registro Italiano with Ing. Barricelli & Comm. Ferretti on 11th instant.

The present position is that the vessels were examined by the R.I. Surveyors in dock at Spezia recently for classification in that Society but our Surveyors were not called . -

Both vessels are now away, but the R.I. have not granted them their classification as one of the motors on each vessel is out of commission . -

It is understood that the R.I. would be disposed to grant a provisional certificate as sailing vessels only, but this does not satisfy the Owner . -

The "**PIETRO BRIZZOLARI**" is expected to arrive shortly at Ancona and the "**MARIA BRIZZOLARI**" is stated to be at Spax, the time of her next arrival in Italy being unknown . -

Under the circumstances it is submitted that the vessels should undergo the necessary survey and repairs on their arrival
