Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 28th ultimo, respecting your steamer "SIRIUS", and in reply thereto I am directed to inform you that the vessel cannot be considered eligible to be classed in the Society's Register until a properly fitted watertight door, controlled from the deck, has been fitted to the opening in the stokehold bulkhead to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors. In the event of the vessel ultimately being classed, and no cargo battens being fitted, the certificate of classification will require to bear the following words, viz:- "Subject to the vessel being engaged exclusively in carrying coal, ore or wood while without cargo battens".
