Referring to your letter of the 25th inst. respecting the case of the new steamer "Sirius", built by Irvin & Co. Ltd., W. Hartlepool, to the order of Mr W. R. B. Lundgren of this port, I beg to acquaint you, that I have today seen this gentleman and conferred with him respecting the necessity of a watertight door, as per rule, being fitted to the forward engine room bulkhead instead of the door now fitted with hinges and bolts. Mr Lundgren informed me that he would not fit a door as required, and would write you himself upon the subject tomorrow. He also stated, that no cargo battens would be required in the holds.
