The class of this vessel is subject to the rudder frame, repaired by Oxy-acetylene process at Glasgow in November 1912, being specially examined at next dry docking.

The Special Survey No. 2, due January 1914, has been partly held. *The machinery survey has been held but the boiler survey became due in 7.15 & the beamⁿ of screw shaft in 11.15*
The case has been deferred from time to time, the vessel being on Government service.

In reply to enquiry the Liverpool Surveyors now state the vessel is still on Government service.

The year of grace expired 1.15.

The case is therefore submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
