The Boiler Survey became due in April 1914, and the screw shaft became due for survey in June last.

As Lloyd's Agent at Palma was unable to find a suitable Surveyor to carry out the surveys at that port, the Owners were asked to make arrangements to have the surveys held at an early date at a port where a Surveyor of the Society is stationed.

In reply the Owners state that in the circumstances they must for the present give up the classification, and they add that when they have a larger number of vessels they will be able to lay them up in turn at Barcelona for the number of days necessary to carry out all the surveys due according to the Society's Rules, and they will then be glad to avail themselves of the Society's services.

The cases received the consideration of the Classing Committee on the 9th instant, when it was decided to withdraw the classes from the Register Book and to insert three dots (...) in lieu thereof in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
