Nature of Survey ss no 2 When due 8 13

The 1st S.S.No.2 became due in August 1913 and a proposal to carry out the survey on the vessel's arrival at Marseilles within two months was approved in March last.

The Marseilles Surveyor stated in September that the vessel was at his port but no progress had been made with the survey since the 11th September, and he was awaiting the Owners instructions.

The case was before the Committee on the 20th October and the Owners were asked to furnish the usual undertaking.

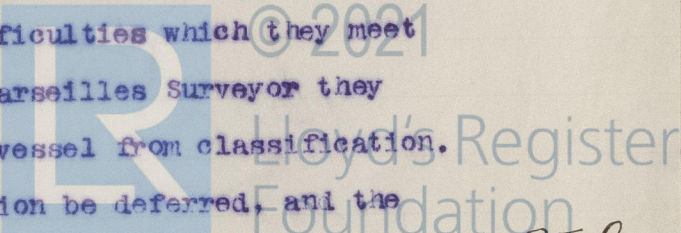
This has not been received by the Marseilles Surveyor stated on the 31st ultimo that the vessel was again under his survey, and he hoped to complete the survey shortly.

A letter has now been received from the Owners stating that owing to the difficulties which they meet in their relations with the Marseilles Surveyor they have decided to withdraw the vessel from classification.
