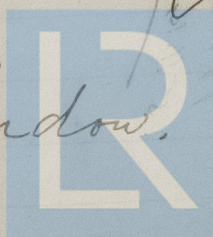
Dear Sir

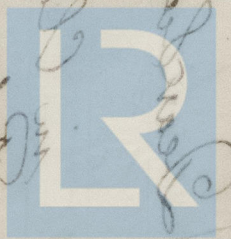
