S.S.No.2, due 8,13.

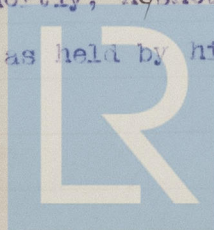
The 1st S.S.No.2 became due in August 1913,
and a proposal to carry out the survey on the vessel's
arrival at Marseilles within two months time was approved in
March last.

The Marseilles Surveyor now states that the vessel
is at his port but no progress has been made with the
Special Survey since 11th September, and he is awaiting the
Owners instructions.

It is submitted action be deferred, and the Owners
be asked to furnish the usual undertaking.
