This trawler became due for Special Survey No. 3 in March, 1920.

The survey was held at Boulogne with the exception of the removal of the mast wedges and the testing of the anchors and chain cables. The rudder and shell plating were repaired by electric welding and acetylene welding in January, 1918, and these require to be examined at each dry docking.

It was proposed to complete the Special Survey without fail when the vessel was next stopped before April last.

Lloyd's Agents at Boulogne have now been informed by the Owners that it is their intention to withdraw the vessel from the Society's Classification and place her with the Bureau Veritas, and in the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, 12th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (6.23), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners have been informed accordingly.
