Stl. Sc. K. "NOTRE DAME DE LOURDES".

The Special Survey No.3 due 3,20 on this vessel has been held except that the mast wedges require to be removed and the anchors and chain cables tested.

The rudder and shell plating repaired by electric welding and acetylene welding in January 1918 (rudder again welded 3,21) require to be specially examined at the next dry docking.

A proposal to complete the Special Survey without fail when the vessel is next stopped before March or April 1923 was agreed to.

Lloyd's Agents at Boulogne stated in May last, however, that the Owners had informed them they intended classing the vessel with the Bureau Veritas, and, in reply to further enquiries as to whether it was proposed to withdraw the classification from this Society's Register, they state that it is the Owners' intention to hand over the classification to the Bureau Veritas.

It is submitted the classification of this vessel be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (6,23) indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
