The 1st. Special Survey No.1 became due in May 1908, and the year of grace expired at the end of May 1909.

The vessel has been lying up in London for a considerable time, and has been allowed to retain her classification as the original Owners, the London County Council, and the City Steamboat Company, Lim., to whom the vessel was sold, furnished the undertaking usual in such cases.

The vessel recently became the property of the Koln-Mulheimer Dampfs.Act.Ges., Mulheim-a-Rhein, and Messrs.J.I.Jacobs, through whom the sale was effected, stated that she had already safely crossed to Rotterdam en route for Germany.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee on the 19th instant, when it was decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
