I am in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant the contents of which have been noted, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that no objection will be taken to the arrangement of welded butt of the stem as approved in your No.238 ship being adopted in future similar cases where paravane stems are fitted.

The electric welding should be carried out to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors and the Regulations for the Application of Electric Arc Welding to Ship Construction should be complied with.
