Dear Sir,

S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th instant respecting the Steam Tug "MORENO", and in reply to say that this vessel was built under the Society's Special Survey and was originally classed "Al Tug - Coasting".

In January 1924, her class was withdrawn from the Register Book at Owners' request, and the notation (...) indicative of this fact still stands against the vessel's name in the Register Book.

To entitle the Tug to re-classification, the requirements of a Special Survey No. 3 would require to be carried out on hull and machinery, and the vessel found or placed in thoroughly good and efficient condition to the entire satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

For your information, I enclose herewith an abstract from the Society's Rules setting forth the requirements of a No. 3 survey.
