on a Ferry boat at Vancouver. (Boilers No M159)


The material of these boilers has been tested in  
accordance with the rules of this Society. The steam  
and water drums, mud drums, and tube sections  
have been tested by hydraulic pressure to 350 lbs.  
(three hundred and fifty pounds) per square inch  
and showed no sign of weakness or defect.

The boilers are to be erected, expanded up and  
tested as complete units at Vancouver.
