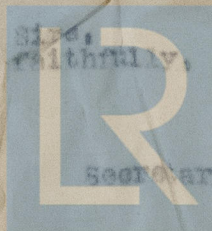

Reverting to my letters of the 11th February last respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of your schooners "EUROPA", "ASIA" and "AMERICA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have again had the cases of these vessels before them at their meeting today, and that in the absence of a reply to my letter above referred to, they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessels' characters to be omitted from the reprint of the Society's Register Book, which is now taking place.

The Committee have also had before them communications from the Society's Surveyors at Buenos Aires from which it appears that it is not your intention to continue the classes of the steamer "TOGO" and ship "OCEANIA", and in the circumstances they have given instructions for the characters of these vessels also to be omitted from the ensuing reprint of the Register Book.
