The Annual Survey of this vessel became due in  
June last. Some damage through striking a dock wall requires  
to be permanently repaired and the vessel examined in dry dock  
before proceeding on another voyage under loaded conditions.

The Owner now states that the engines were  
removed from the vessel last Spring and that she is now lying in  
the River Blackwater in use as a houseboat, and he does not desire  
to maintain the classification in the Society's Register Book.

In the circumstances the Classing Committee, who  
had the case before them on Friday, 18th instant, decided to give  
instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the  
Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof,  
indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.
