

FEES for the SURVEY of FERRO-CONCRETE Vessels
While Building.

It is submitted that the construction of FERRO-CONCRETE Vessels necessitates the more frequent attendance of Surveyors than in the case of Steel Vessels, as unless the Surveyors are present when the Concrete is being placed, it is not practicable for them to know that the work has been satisfactorily done or that the steel reinforcement is in its proper position.

This would apply to all vessels of this method of construction, whether they be Sister Ships to others built before or not.

The fees charged for the survey of FERRO-CONCRETE Vessels are consistent with the services rendered by the Surveyors, not only at the building yard during the course of construction, but in connection with the examination of plans which is also of a much more extensive character than in the case of Steel Vessels.

It is not considered that any reduction should be made in the fees charged for the survey of these vessels, which are three times the normal fees on the hull and the ordinary classification fees for machinery, plus travelling expenses.
