Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 23rd instant respecting the Vertical Cross Tube Donkey Boiler to be constructed by Messrs. A/S Smith, Mygind & Huttemeier for the M.S. "CHILE", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that Plan No. 47860 of this boiler will be approved, as now amended, for a working pressure of 8 kgs. per sq. cm., provided the welding be carried out with approved electrodes to your satisfaction and the boiler be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing. The plan is returned herewith.

It is concluded that the firebox will be suitably heat treated on completion of the welding and before being riveted to the shell.

The amendments now proposed in way of the manhole compensating ring and the connection of the uptake tube to the furnace crown plate have been noted on the copy of the plan retained in this Office.
