Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant, respecting the S.S. "PETUNIA", belonging to the Admiralty, and in reply to your enquiry, have to acquaint you that this vessel was built by Messrs. Workman, Clark & Co. Ltd., to the order of the Admiralty, and was completed in May, 1916.

The steamer was constructed under the Special Survey of the Surveyors to this Society, and upon completion was classed by the Committee Al. for Government Service.

I should add that the vessel's dimensions are 255.2 x 33.5 x 17.3, and that she has Triple Expansion Engines with four cylinders 21½ x 35 x 40 (2), with 13" stroke. The nominal Horse Power is 347.

As explained to your Representative when he called here, the particulars of the vessel have not been recorded in the Society's Register Book, in accordance with arrangements made with the Admiralty.
