The 1st Special Survey No.2, which became due on this vessel in April last, has been partly held, and some frames in the engine+boiler space require to be repaired.

The year of grace expired at the end of April last, and the Owners did not reply to a letter addressed to them on the 12th May with regard to the repairs, and completion of the survey.

The Hull Surveyors now state they have been in communication with the Owners, but are unable to obtain any satisfactory reply. They add that having regard to the state of the framing when the engine and boiler space was examined in 1914, and as no effort has been made to carry out the repairs then recommended, they are of the opinion that the vessel's class should now be expunged.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee on the 6th instant, when it was decided to expunge the vessel's class from the Register Book with a red line ( 7.15 ), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners have been so informed.
